

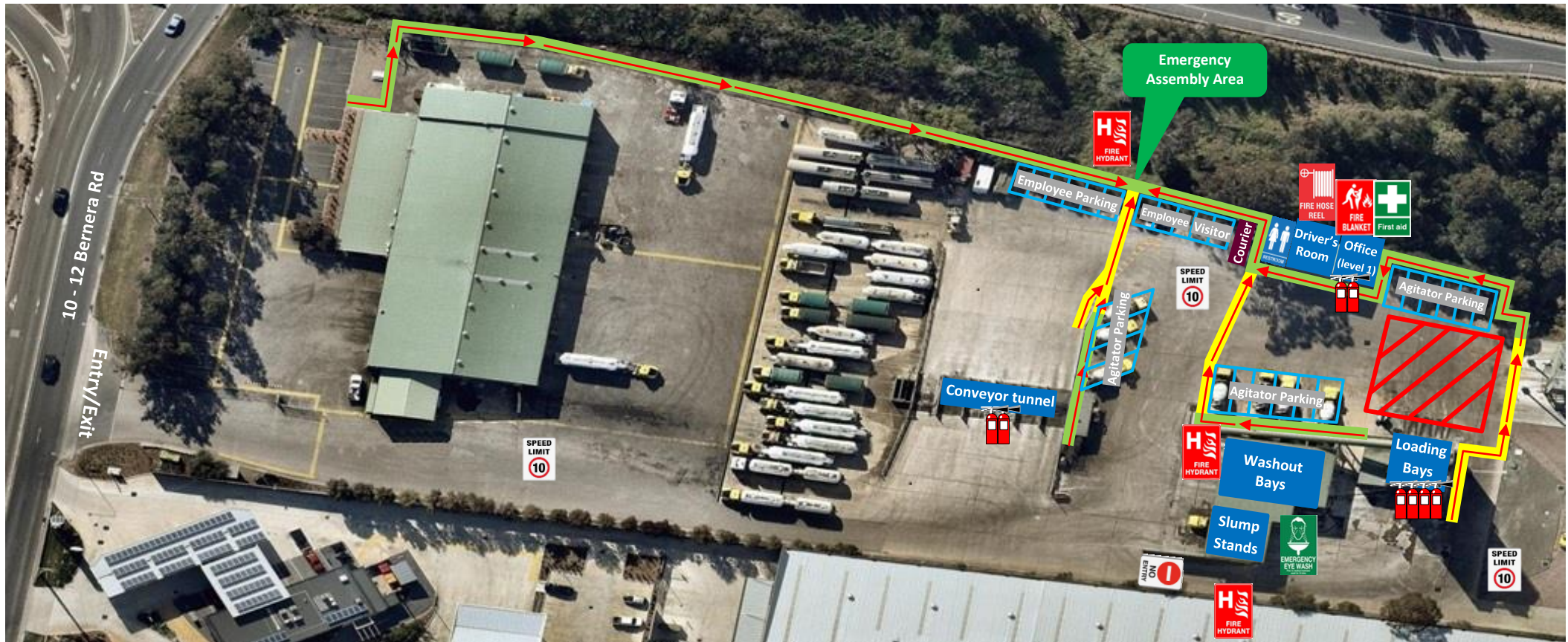

### Pedestrians

**Protected Walkway**

**Designated Walkway**  
Pedestrians **MUST** give way to vehicles and plant

**Pedestrian Exclusion Zone**  
Only authorised pedestrians are permitted to conduct work in operational areas

### Emergency Equipment



#### Fire Hydrants

Located at rear of Employee Parking, rear of Agitator Parking, opposite noise reduction wall



#### Fire Blanket

2 located in office



#### First Aid

Located in office



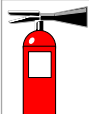
#### Fire Hose Reel

Located behind Office block



#### Emergency Assembly Area

Located at rear of Employee Parking. Proceed to the Assembly point using the designated walkways



#### Fire Extinguishers

Located in each of the following areas:  
2 located in Office, 2 located in Conveyor tunnel, Washout Bays. Loading Bay – Ground floor, Level 1, Level 2, Mezzanine



#### Emergency Eye Wash

Located near entrance to Slump Stands

### Pedestrians

-  **Pedestrian Exclusion Zone**  
Only authorised pedestrians are permitted to conduct work in operational areas

### Vehicles and Plant



#### Vehicle Route

Follow the direction of the vehicle route. Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.



#### Reverse entry



#### Site Speed Limit

The site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.



#### Visitor Parking

- There are 2 parking bays allocated to visitors. Parking is reverse entry.
- Report to the Office immediately upon arrival (office is located upstairs). Follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.



#### Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift

- Operate in all areas.
- Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres. Communicate with the Loader operator via UHF channel 17.

### Vehicles and Plant

-  **Vehicle Route**

-  **Reverse entry**
-  **Site Speed Limit**  
The site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.
-  **Courier Parking**
  - There is 1 parking bay allocated to couriers. Parking is reverse entry.
  - Report to the Office immediately upon arrival (office is located upstairs). Follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.
-  **Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift**
  - Operate in all areas.
  - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres. Communicate with the Loader operator via UHF channel 17.

-  **Reverse Entry**
-  **Site Speed Limit**  
The site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.
-  **Washout Waste Loading Location – Reverse entry**  
**Note:** If vehicles do not have on-board truck scales, you must proceed to the weighbridge before leaving site. To access the office, follow the pathway directional arrows as indicated on the map.
-  **Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift**
  - Operate in all areas.
  - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres. Communicate with the Loader operator via UHF channel 17.

-  **Contractor Parking**
  - Contractors park in the visitor parking bays. Parking is reverse entry.
  - Upon arrival, report to the office for induction and further instructions (office is located upstairs). Follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.
-  **Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift**
  - Operate in all areas.
  - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres. Communicate with the Loader operator via UHF channel 17.
