When do I need to complete a work diary?


- · Operating on BFM.
- Anytime you drive 100 km radius from your base or if your I360 unit is not operational.

What is work time?

 Anytime spent driving, loading, unloading, refuelling or work associated with the vehicle.

What is rest time?

· Anytime not working in a fatigue regulated heavy vehicle



On page 32 drivers must complete the address of their base depot & the address where records are kept.

- · Records are kept at 10 Bernera Rd, Prestons NSW 2170
- Do not write on duplicate copies.
- YELLOW duplicate copy inc. cancelled & unused must be handed in to your supervisor or placed into appropriate box at ALL Truck parking locations
- You must use a work diary if you work under BFM, AFM hours regardless if you work either inside or outside a 100 km radius from your base.
- Driver to sign the Work Diary Page before starting a new daily sheet
