
 **First Aid**

Located near the entry/exit gate. Follow the pathway directional arrows as indicated on the map.

 **Fire Blanket**
Located in Batch Office

 **Main Electrical**
Located beneath Fly Ash Silo

 **Fire Extinguishers**
Located in each of the following areas:
Batch Office, Driver's Room, adjacent to Truck Wash area, top of Material storage bins, rear external wall of Driver's room, Front End Loader.




 **Spill Kit**
Located in Batch Office

Visitor Parking

- No Visitor parking on site (street parking only).
- Visitors must enter the site via the Pedestrian Site entrance.
- All visitors must report to the Batch Office immediately upon arrival on site (located upstairs). Follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the Batch Office, as indicated on the map.



Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift

- Operate in all areas.
- Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres.

Vehicles and Plant

- Vehicle Route**
Follow the direction of the vehicle route. Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
- Site Speed Limit**
The Site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.
- Courier Parking**
 - There is 1 parking bay allocated to Couriers. If the Courier parking bay is unavailable, Couriers must park off site.
 - Report to the Batch Office immediately upon arrival on site (located upstairs). Follow the pathway directional arrows to and from office, as indicated on the map.
- Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift**
 - Operate in all areas.
 - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres.

-  **Vehicle Route**
Follow the direction of the vehicle route. Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
-  **Reverse Entry**
-  **Site Speed Limit**
The Site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.
-  **Heavy Vehicle Delivery Points**
Unloading area 1 – is for deliveries of large or heavy loads which generally require forklift removal (Reverse entry)
Unloading area 2 – is for deliveries of lightweight material (forward entry).
To access the office block, follow the pathway directional arrows as indicated on the map.
-  **Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift**
 - Operate in all areas.
 - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres.

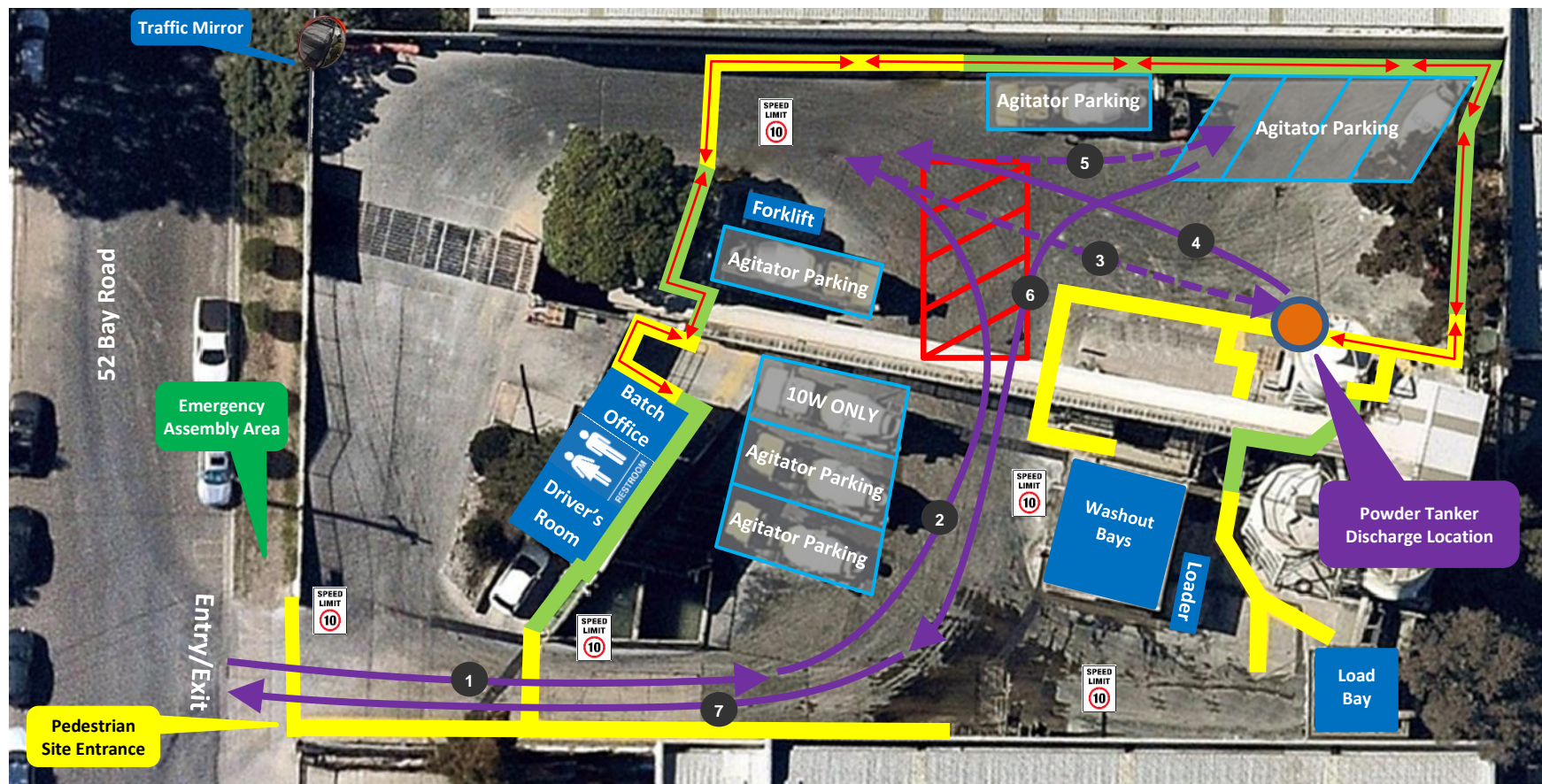

Vehicle Route

Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 – 7. Note, steps 4 & 5 may be required to assist the larger tankers when preparing to exit the site after discharging. Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.

Site Speed Limit

The Site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.



Powder Tanker Discharge Location – Reverse entry

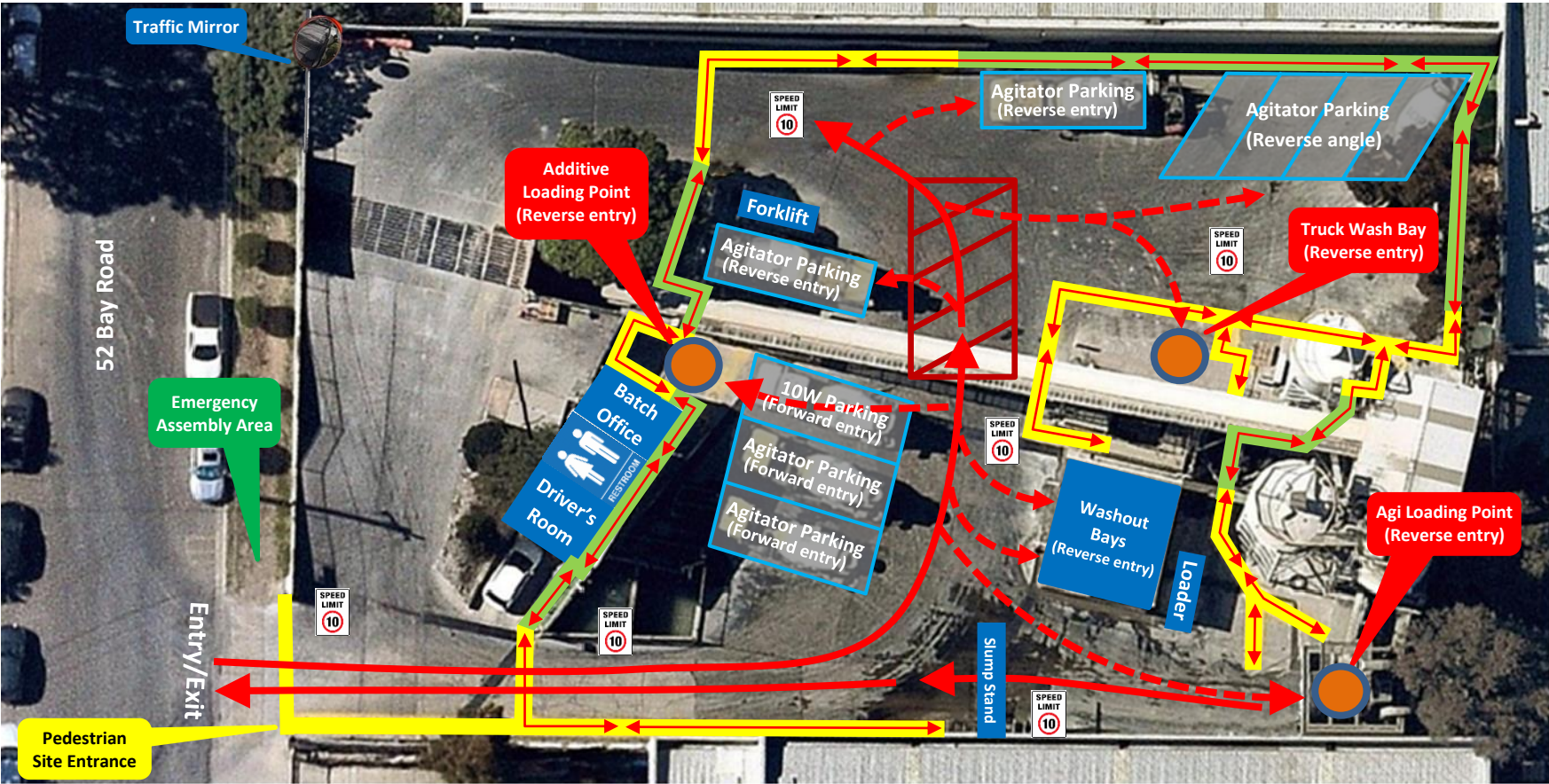

The Site speed limit is restricted to 10kph.
- Contractor Parking**
 - Parking in the first 3 Agitator parking bays is permitted.
 - Upon arrival, Contractors report to the Batch Office for induction and further instructions (located upstairs). Follow the pathway directional arrow as indicated on the map.
 - Once directed to your set up location, it is the Contractor's responsibility to erect Traffic cones or reflective bollards around the work area.
- Front End Loader (FEL) and Forklift**
 - Operate in all areas.
 - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres.
