




- No Visitor parking on site (street parking only).

Vehicles and Plant

-  **Vehicle Route**
Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 – 7.
 - At step 2, driver must STOP and wait for the boom barrier to open automatically.
 - At step 4, reverse entry to the Loading Bay.
 - Once loading is complete, follow steps 5 & 6 to the Slump Stands.
 - Follow step 7 to exit the site.

Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.

The site speed limit is restricted to 10kph
-  **Agitator Loading Point**
 - Reverse entry
 - When access to the office is required, follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.
-  **Agitator Parking Bays**
 - Reverse entry
 - Parking opposite the Washout bays is forward entry
-  **Backhoe and Forklift**
 - Operate in all areas.
 - Have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres.

Vehicles and Plant



Vehicle Route

- Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 – 4.
- At step 2, driver must **STOP** and wait for the boom barrier to open automatically.
 - At step 4, reverse entry to Washout Bays 1 or 2.
 - Once washout is complete, continue to Loading or parking.

Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.

Washout Bays

- Reverse entry
- When access to the office is required, follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.



Agitator Parking Bays

- Parking opposite the Washout bays is forward entry.
- To park in the remaining parking bays, you must exit the site and re-enter via the entry gate.

- Reverse entry onto the site and continue reversing back to the Loading location.
- Once loading is complete, forward exit the site.

Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.

Washout Waste Loading Location

- Reverse entry
- The collection of Washout Waste only occurs when there are no Agitator trucks parked in the area.
- When access to the office is required, follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.

Contractor Parking

- Contractors are to park off site (street parking) and enter the site via the Pedestrian Site entrance.
- Upon arrival, Contractors must report to the office for induction and further instructions. Follow the pathway directional arrows to and from the office, as indicated on the map.



Vehicle Route

Follow the direction of the vehicle route.

Refuelling Location 1 – follow steps 1 – 2

Refuelling Location 2 – follow steps 1 – 5

- At step 2, driver must STOP and wait for the boom barrier to open automatically.
- At step 4, reverse into refuelling position.
- Once refuelling is complete, follow step 5 to exit the site.

Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
