Check the bodies contamination	 Tipper Ensure to open tailgates Ensure the tarps are open Engage PTO Raise body up (one at a time) Ensure the body is going up straight When body is completely extended, ensure the tipper controls are in HOLD position and disengage PTO before exiting the cab Ensure 3 points of contact when exiting the cab Inspect the bodies If contamination is present proceed to wash out the bodies If bodies are clean, enter the cab, lower the bodies, ensure to lock the tailgates and exit inspection area/ wash bay Live Bottom Semi Trailer Open tarp Engage PTO Ensure to open tailgate/doors Inspect the bodies via on-board cameras If contamination is present proceed to wash out the bodies If live bottom is clean, ensure to lock the tailgate/doors, disengage PTO and exit inspection area/ wash bay

		Live Bottom - Ensure to carry out belt remote	
		control - Ensure to prop/isolate the tailgate/doors - Ensure to stay clear minimum 1 metre from the rear of the live bottom semi-trailer when washing out - Hose out live bottom semi-trailer with the belt stopped then staying clear of the rear tailgate/doors, chain and belt, restart the belt one rotation then hose out that side until all clean - Return hose to its location
