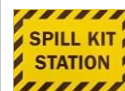
### Pedestrians

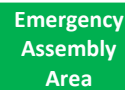
**First Aid**

Located directly in front of Storage shed



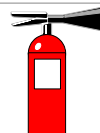
**Emergency Eye Wash**

**Emergency Assembly Area**  
Located at Gate 1, near the Visitor parking area. Follow the pathway directional arrows as indicated on the map.



**Main Electrical**  
Located beside Loading Bay






**Fire Extinguishers**  
Located in the following areas:  
Site Office, Batch Office, Load Bay (level 1), directly in front of Loading Bay, Storage Shed, Front End Loader, all trucks are equipment with fire extinguishers.

Only authorised pedestrians are permitted to conduct work in operational areas

### Vehicles and Plant

-  **Vehicle Route**  
Enter & Exit via Gate 1.  
Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 3. At step 2, reverse into the visitor parking area.  
Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
-  **Reverse Entry**
-  **Visitor Parking – reverse entry**  
All visitors must report to the Site office immediately upon arrival.
-  To access the Site office and site facilities, follow the pathway directional arrows, as indicated on the map.
- Driving Rules**
  - 10 km/hr speed limit, unless otherwise marked.
  - Obey road rules.
  - Front End Loader and Forklift have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres. Communicate with the Loader operator via UHF Channel 31.
  - Drive to conditions.
  - No hand-held mobile device whilst driving.

### Vehicles and Plant

-  **Vehicle Route**  
Enter & Exit via Gate 1. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to entering and upon exiting site.  
Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 3.
  - At step 2, reverse into the unloading area
  - Once unloading is complete, follow step 3 to exit the site.
 Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
-  **Reverse Entry**
-  **Delivery Location – reverse entry**
-  To access the Office and site facilities, follow the pathway directional arrows, as indicated on the map.

#### Driving Rules

- 10 km/hr speed limit, unless otherwise marked.
- Obey road rules.

### Vehicles and Plant



#### Vehicle Route

Enter via Gate 1. Exit via Gate 2. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to entering and exiting site.

Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 6.

- At step 3, reverse into the stockpile area to discharge load.
- Once discharging is complete, follow steps 4 - 6 to exit the site. Upon exiting, Tippers must give way to Agitators and Loader operating in the Load alley.

Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.



#### Reverse Entry



#### Tipper Discharge Location – reverse entry

- Unloading into the overhead bins is not permitted.
- Tippers are not permitted to travel beyond the Admixture bund area.
- No dogs allowed to unload in the 10mm bins due to uneven ground.
- Unhook & re-hook trailers in the Trailer Parking area

#### Driving Rules

- 10 km/hr speed limit, unless otherwise marked.
- Obey road rules.
- Front End Loader and Forklift have right of way in vehicle operating areas. Always establish positive communication (verbal and/or visual contact) with operator before approaching within 20 metres. Communicate with the Loader operator via UHF Channel 31.

### Vehicles and Plant



#### Vehicle Route

Enter via Gate 1. Exit via Gate 2. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to entering and exiting site.

Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 6.

- At step 1, stop and collect keys from Site office.
- At step 3, reverse to the discharge points
- Once discharging is complete, follow steps 4 - 6 to exit the site. Upon exiting, Tankers must give way to Agitators and Loader operating in the Load alley.

Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.

### Vehicles and Plant

- Vehicle Route**  
Enter via Gate 1. Exit via Gate 2. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to entering and exiting site.  
Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 6.
  - At step 2, forward entry to the discharge point.
  - Once discharging is complete, follow step 3 to reverse from discharge point, then steps 4-6 to exit the site. Upon exiting, Tankers must give way to Agitators and Loader operating in the Load alley.

### Vehicles and Plant

- Vehicle Route**  
Enter via Gate 1. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to entering site.  
Follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 6.
  - At step 3, reverse to the Washout Bays.
  - Once washout is complete, follow steps 4 – 6 to proceed to the Agitator parking area. Give way to Agitators and Loader operating in the Load alley.
 Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
- Reverse Entry**
- 1 2 3  
Washout Bays **Washout Bays**  
Reverse into the washout and waste collection pits. Wash-out pipes are located at each pit.

  - Once loading is complete, follow step 3 to drive forward to the Slump Stand.
  - Once slumping is complete, follow steps 4 & 5 to exit the site via Gate 2. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to exiting site.
 Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.

-  **Slump Stand**  
**Slump Stand – forward entry**

-  To access the Office and site facilities, follow the pathway directional arrows as indicated on the map.

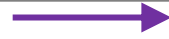

### Vehicles and Plant



#### Vehicle Route

- Enter via Gate 2 and follow the direction of the vehicle route, steps 1 - 4. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to entering site.
- At step 1 & 2, forward into the parking area, then reverse into the Load Bay.
  - Once loading is complete, follow step 3 to drive forward to the Slump Stand.
  - Once slumping is complete, follow step 4 to exit the site via Gate 2. Driver must call on channel 31 prior to exiting site.
- Drivers **MUST** not exit their vehicle unless they can access a designated walkway or to complete designated work.
